

Absence of WADA Prohibited Substances

Confirmation

We confirm that for the manufacture of our nutritional ingredients¹ used as ingredients in food, beverage and supplement applications, we do not use substances that appear on the [World Anti-Doping Code \(WADA\) prohibited list 2025](#) with the exception of mannitol (plasma expander) in its function as sweetener.

The use of mannitol is outlined in the composition sheet of the concerned product.

According to the World Anti-Doping Agency, mannitol is only prohibited for intravenous administration. Hence, our nutritional ingredients do not fall in the scope of the prohibited list of the International Standard of the World Anti-Doping Code.

By proper sealing and storage of our packaging units, we do not see a risk that our ingredients could come into contact with this WADA prohibited substance.
